

# **OBJECTIVES**

Do you have a research project in contempotary philosophy? Do you want to use English as a working language? The Contemporay Philosophy Master offers an international course focused on contemporay philosophy debates and taught at the UMR STL (Knowledge, Texts, Language research lab) and at the philosophy department.

# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

IN SECOND YEAR (M2)

To apply in Master 2 Contemporary Philosophy:

- You are an international or European English-speaking student in possession of a +4 years post-secondary degree, which includes 2 years of philosophy
- Or you have a different degree, but a personal or professional experience in connection with philosophy
- You have a detailed research project in Contemporary (i.e. post 1945) philosophy

# **JOINT 2 YEARS PROGRAM WITH LISBON**

The M2 Contemporary philosophy program in Lille is now coupled with a M1 in Philosophy taught entirely in English at the Univ. of Lisbon (Portugal). Students following both years will earn a Master's degree from both universities.

To enter this program, you must apply for the M1 program in Lille (with a research project written in English and a proof of your English level).

# **ORGANIZATION**

The Master contains two elements:

- Active involvement in required classes and seminars you chose.
- Research paper writing (M1: minimum 50 pages, M2: minimum 75 pages), under the supervision of a teacher/researcher from the Philosophy Department. You will need to present your paper in front of a jury. This paper involves an important personal investment as well as frequent exchanges with the paper supervisor.

# THE FACULTY

The Faculty of Humanities trains close to 7000 students in diverse fields of study such as archeology, arts, history and history of art, modern literature, classics, philosophy and language science.

The Faculty is made up of of seven formation departments, five research labs and several libraries.

Within the Faculty, the Philosophy Department offers to its students complete philosophical training courses, such as 3 Master's degree:

- Arts, Ethic Policy and Society
- Contemporary Philosophy
- Philosophy, Knowledge, Rationalities

The department also trains for the aggregation of philosophy and takes part in courses of the master

« Métiers de l'enseignement, de l'Education et de la Formation » (Teaching, Education and Formation Professions) in collaboration with the INSPÉ (National Higher Institute of Teaching and Éducation).

The Department of Philosophy is composed of a teaching team of 16 tenured professors/researchers along with several part time or contracted teachers, as well as an administrative and technical team of two.

Training courses in the Department are supported by the UMR STL (Knowledge, Texts, Language research lab), in which most of the professors/researchers in philosophy develop their research activities.
